Participants


The event was exclusively organized for final-year B.Sc and M.Sc science students. Over 150 students attended the training session, actively engaging in discussions and workshops.

program. This initiative significantly contributed to empowering students with essential skills and boosting their confidence to face the competitive job market.

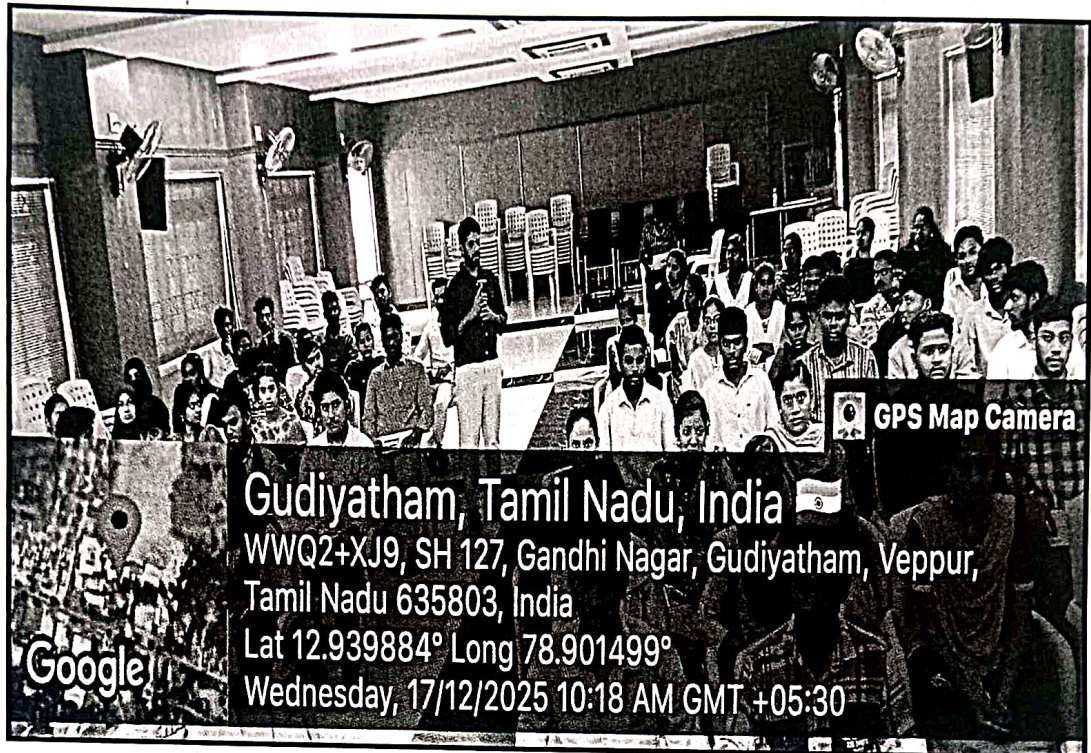

MOU Exchange & Honoring Ceremony

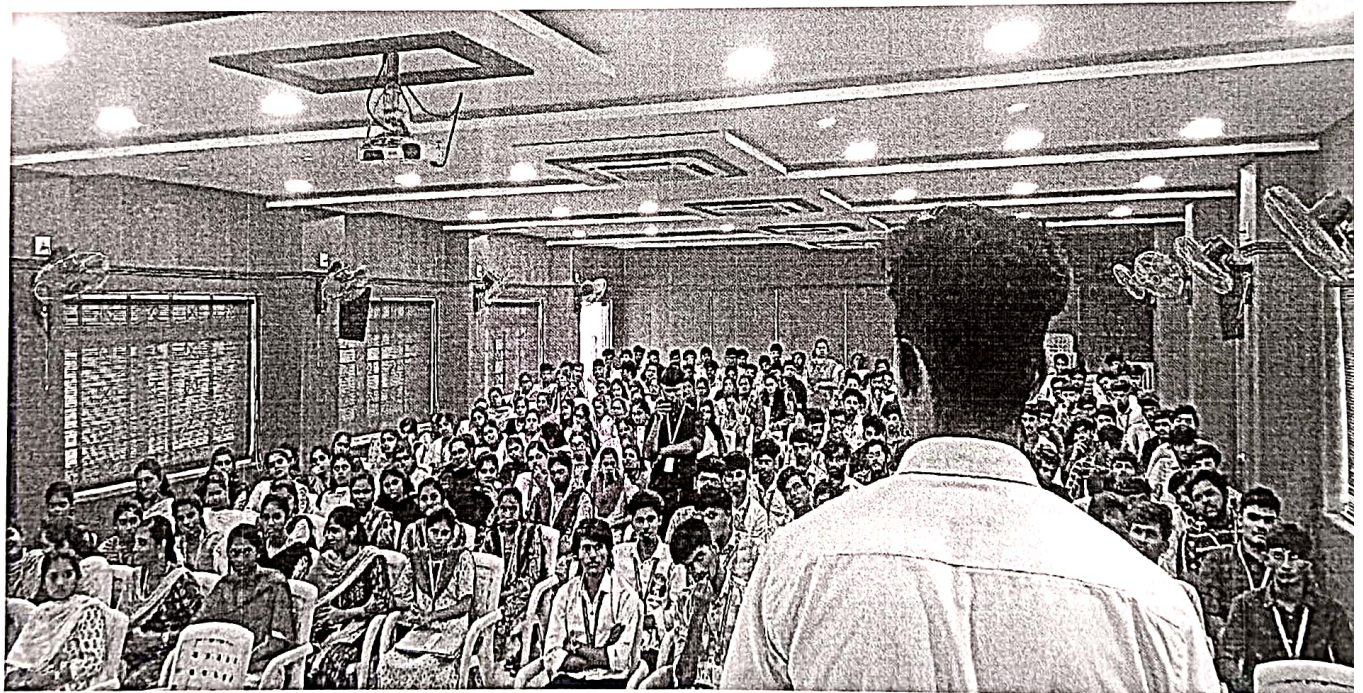
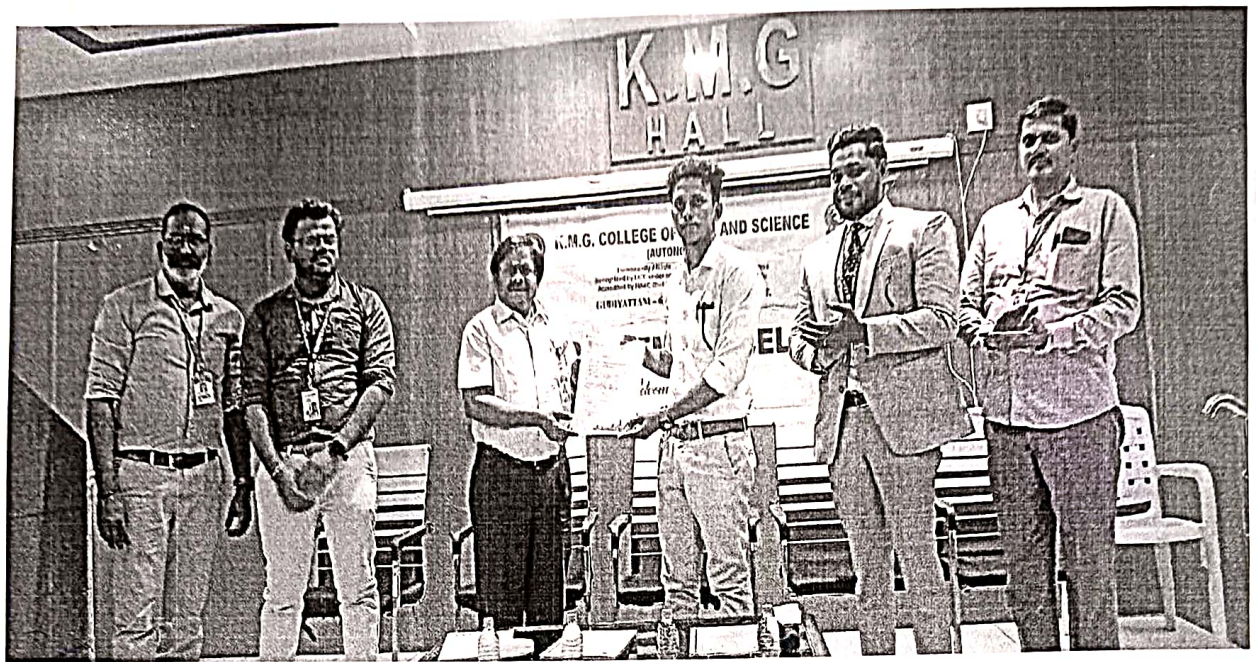



Campus Drive-2025-2026

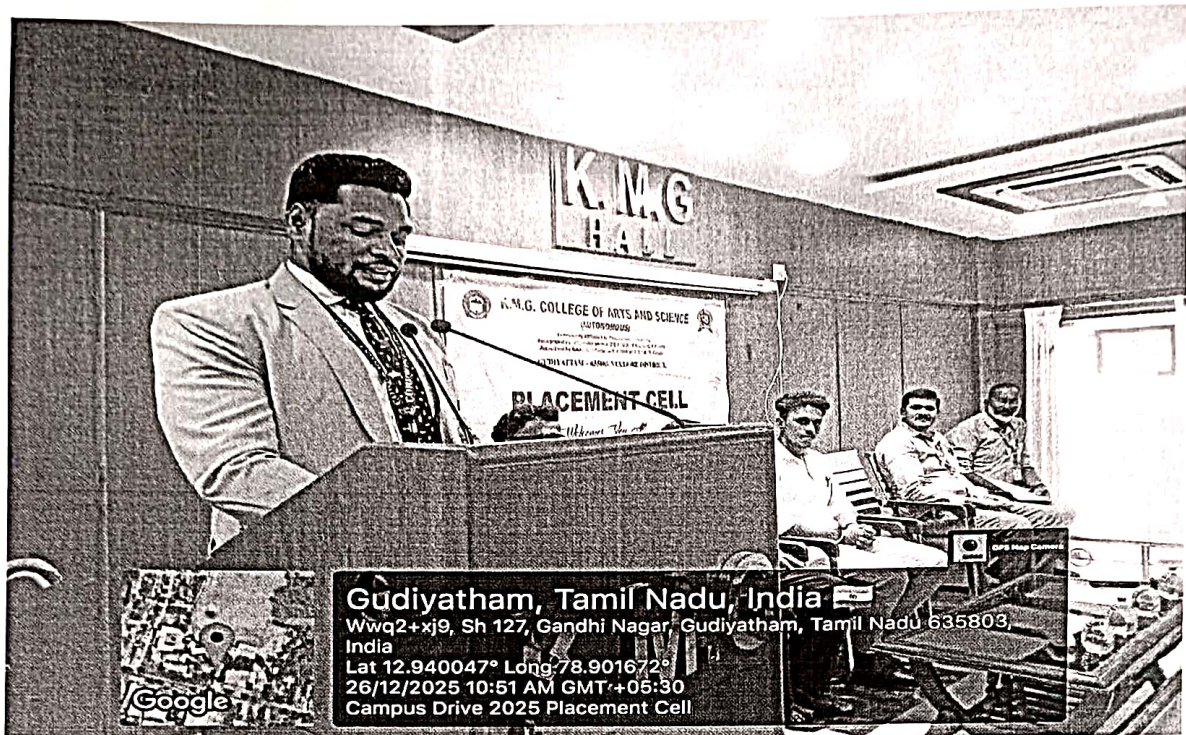
