NEW COURSES

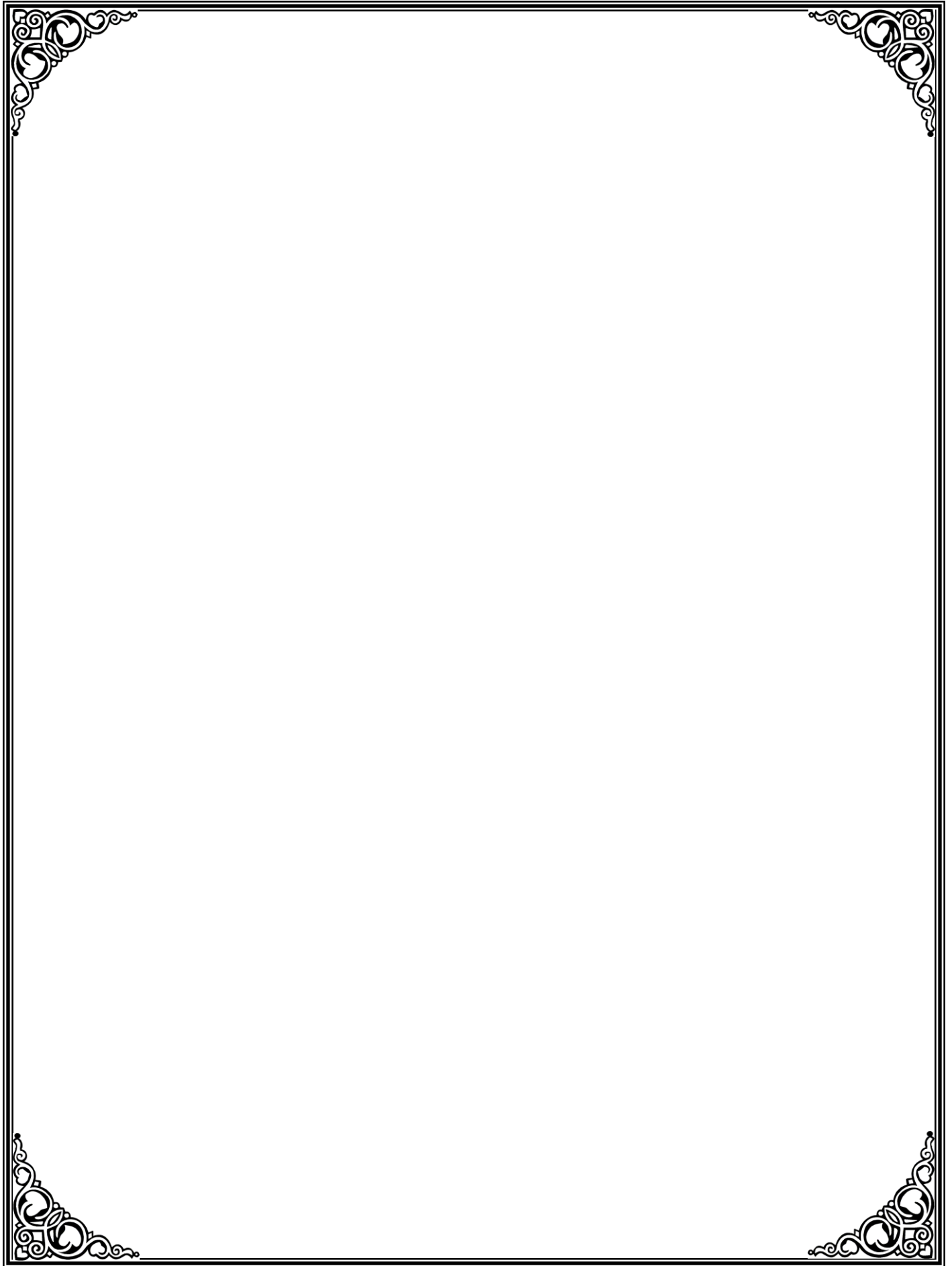
