We have introduce M.Phil in Chemistry from this academic year. Except Business Administration and Microbiology, all other Depts have Post Graduate and Research programs.We have applied for starting Ph.D program in Commerce from next academic year.

Though financially not viable we intend to introduce these courses to fulfill our ambition to convert this institution into a full fledged Research Institution. That was the vision of our beloved founder lyah who wished and lived for converting Gudiyattam into an educational hub where students can become qualified to the highest level at an affordable cost.

I thank the Management for helping the poor students of this area to convert their aspirations into achievements. This year we have totally waived the fees for 9 Students one from each Degree Course till they complete their 3 year program. This scheme is under Universal Higher Education Scheme.
