





M/s. Kunja Kowsalya Ammal Govindarajan Educational and Charitable trust, being the educational agency of KMG College of Arts and Science, was promoted in the year 1999, by the vision of late Shri. K. M. Govindarajan, with a mission to offer higher education in the fields of Arts, Science and Teacher education to the needy and the poor middle class students belonging to this area and make them fully employable and economically self reliant.

The trust, besides KMG College of Arts and Science, has also promoted the Educational Institutions under the name and style of Thiruvalluvar Teacher Training Institute to offer two year Diploma in Teacher Education and KMG College of Education, to offer two year B.Ed., course. The sister institutions of our trust are Elementary School and Higher Secondary School, with a total strength of 8000 students, both boys and girls.

The College was started on 10th September, 2000, with the permission of Tamilnadu Government and was originally affiliated to Madras University and subsequently transferred to Thiruvalluvar University. Now, the college is recognized under section 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act 1956 and permanently affiliated to Thiruvalluvar University. With an initial strength of 196 in 2000, our enrolment has now increased to 2210 in the academic year (2020-2021). The College has been accredited by NAAC with A Grade. Our college got Autonomy Status from the Academic Year 2024-2025.

From a humble beginning of 5 Under Graduate Programmes started in the very first year of opening of the college, now it offers 12 Under Graduate Programmes, 8 Post Graduate Programmes, 4 Ph.D., Research Programmes at the sprawling campus of 15 acres of land in Ammanankuppam just 3km from Gudiyattam town and 1km from Gudiyattam railway station.

1. மாணவர்கள் கல்லூரிக்கு உள்ளேயும் வெளியேயும் மிக உயர்ந்த நடத்தை மற்றும் ஒழுக்கத்தை பராமரிக்க கோரப்படுகிறார்கள்.
2. தினசரி இறைவணக்கம் கூட்டம் காலை 09.50 மணிக்கு நடத்தப்படும். முடியும் வரை அந்தந்த வகுப்பறைகளில் எழுந்து நிற்குமாறு மாணவர்களுக்கு அறிவுறுத்தப்படுகிறது.
3. மாணவர்கள் காலை 9.45 மணிக்குள் கல்லூரிக்கு வர வேண்டும். அதற்கு பின் வரும் மாணவர்கள் கல்லூரிக்குள் அனுமதிக்கப்படமாட்டார்கள்.
4. அனைத்து மாணவர்களும் கல்லூரி வளாகத்தில் இருக்கும்போது அடையாள அட்டையை அணிய வேண்டும்.
5. மாணவர்கள் கல்லூரிக்கு ஏற்படைய ஆடைகளை அணிந்து கொண்டு வர வேண்டும்.
6. மாணவர்கள் முறையான ஆடை அணிய அறிவுறுத்தப்படுகிறது. மாணவர்கள் ஜீன்ஸ் பேன்ட், லைக்கரா மற்றும் டி-சர்ட்டுகள், மாணவிகள் லெக்கின், பட்டியலா போன்றவை அணிய அனுமதிக்கப்படாது.
7. மாணவர்களுக்கு தலைமுடியை சரியாக வெட்ட அறிவுறுத்தப்படுகிறது. இல்லையெனில், அவர்கள் கல்லூரிக்குள் அனுமதிக்கப்பட மாட்டார்கள்.
8. மாணவர்கள் அடுத்தடுத்த செமஸ்டருக்கு பதவி உயர்வுகளைப் பெறுவதற்காக பல்கலைக்கழகம் / கல்லூரி தேர்வுகளில் தங்கள் செய்திறனில் நிலைத்தன்மையை மேம்படுத்தவும் பராமரிக்கவும் வேண்டும்.
9. கல்லூரியால் உருவாக்கப்பட்ட ஒழுங்கு விதிகளை மாணவர்கள் கண்டிப்பாக கடைப்பிடிக்கவேண்டும். மீறினால் கல்லூரி முதல்வர் எடுக்கும் முடிவே இறுதியானது.
10. ஆடைக் குறியீட்டை மீறும் பட்சத்தில் மாணவர்களிடமிருந்து அடையாள அட்டை பறிமுதல் செய்யப்பட்டு, குழுவின் எச்சரிக்கை அல்லது ஆலோசனையுடன் அவர்களிடம் ஒப்படைக்கப்படும்.
11. பெற்றோர்கள் மட்டுமே தங்கள் பிள்ளைகளை சந்திக்க கல்லூரிக்குள் அனுமதிக்கப்படுவார்கள்.
12. மாணவர்கள் கல்லூரி வளாகத்தில் உள்ள அனைத்து ஆசிரியர்களையும் மதிக்க வேண்டும்
13. மாணவர்கள் எந்தவொரு தவறான நடத்தை / ஒழுக்கமற்ற செயல்களில் ஈடுபட்டால் விசாரணை செய்யப்பட்டு முதல்வரின் ஒப்புதலுடன் ஒழுங்கு குழுவால் நடவடிக்கை எடுக்கப்படும்.
14. மாணவர்கள் கல்லூரிக்குள் எந்தவிதமான ஒழுக்கக்கேடான, சட்டவிரோதமான செயல்களில் ஈடுபடக்கூடாது. அத்தகைய மாணவர்கள் உடனடியாக கல்லூரியில் இருந்து நீக்கப்படுவார்கள்.
15. மாணவர்கள் ஒழுக்கமற்ற செயல்களில் ஈடுபடக்கூடாது. அவர்கள் கல்லூரிக்குள் ஒழுக்கத்தைக் கடைப்பிடிக்க வேண்டும். இது மிக முக்கியமானது.

16. முதல் மணி ஒலித்துவடன் மாணவர்கள் தங்கள் வகுப்பு அறைகளில் கூடி ஆசிரியர்கள் வரும் வரை அமைதியாக காத்திருக்க வேண்டும். ஆசிரியர்கள் வகுப்பறைக்குள் நுழையும் போது, மாணவர்கள் எழுந்து நிற்கவேண்டும்.
17. ஆசிரியர்களின் அனுமதியின்றி எந்த மாணவரும் வகுப்பிற்குள் நுழையவோ அல்லது வகுப்பை விட்டு வெளியேறவோ கூடாது.
18. மாணவர்களிடமிருந்து ஏதேனும் புகார்கள் அல்லது குறைகள் பெறப்பட்டால் நடவடிக்கை எடுக்கப்படும்.
19. ஒவ்வொரு வகுப்பு பொறுப்பாசிரியர் மற்றும் கல்வி ஆலோசகர் மாணவர்களின் வருகை, முன்னேற்றம் மற்றும் நடத்தை ஆகியவற்றை உன்னிப்பாக கண்காணிக்க வேண்டும்.
20. மாணவர்கள் ஒழுங்கற்ற வருகை, வகுப்பு வேலை மற்றும் தேர்வில் அலட்சியம், ஆசிரியர்களிடம் அலட்சியம், கீழ்ப்படியாமை, வார்த்தை மற்றும் செயலில் ஆபாசமாக நடந்துகொள்வது, கல்லூரி சொத்துக்களை வேண்டுமென்றே சேதப்படுத்துதல், சமூக விளாசை செயல்கள் போன்றவற்றில் ஈடுபட்டால் கல்லூரியில் இருந்து வெளியேற்றப்படுவதோடு அவர்கள் மீது ஒழுங்கு நடவடிக்கை எடுக்கப்படும்.

LIBRARY RULES

Staff and students should bear the above in mind while making use of library books. The Central Library which has been built to the International Standards. The library is computerized and is a digital library with RFID (Radio Frequency Identification), well protected with fire alarms and RFFID security gate. Searching, issuing and returning of books are done through computers. The students are advised to keep their bar-coded identity card (ID) safely and not to lend their ID for borrowing books.

RFID

All the books are fixed with RFID tags in the library. If any book is taken out without issuing, we have RFID security system which will give an alarm. RFID security system will also keep a record of all the books that has gone out without being issued.

At the circulation counter, with RFID being enabled, it becomes very easy and much faster for processing the transactions. The book will be issued or returned by just placing them on the Staff station. The RFID staff station is capable of reading multiple items at a time. Books can be issued/returned at the same time.

1. All students of the college are members of the college library.
2. Every student using the library will be given two "Borrower Cards", bearing his/her roll number, name, course and section. Each student is permitted to borrow two books at a time from the library.
3. Students will be entitled to keep a book for one week from the date of issue. The book must be returned to the library, on the due date marked on the date slip. But it may be reissued to the same person if there is no demand for that book. When reissued, the book may be retained for a further period of one week. The book should be produced at the library for every renewal. Each student is permitted only two renewals for a book, if not required by any other student during the period.
4. A student failing to return a book on the due date will be fined one rupee for each day after the due date until he/she returns it to the library.

5. The library is open on all the working days of the college.
6. Every student who wishes to take a book from the library shall fill in the application form and present it at the issue counter of the library.
7. Books will be issued to students in exchange for a library card during the working hours of the library as specified by the librarian.
8. While returning a book, the borrower must take back his/her card. Otherwise he/she will be held responsible for the book taken on that card from the library.
9. Final year students must surrender their cards at the end of the academic year.

ISSUE OF CERTIFICATES

To get the course certificate, the students should submit an application, stating the reason for the need of the course certificate, signed by him/her, countersigned by the Parent/Guardian and Tutor/HOD. Only then, the certificate will be issued by the college authorities. This procedure has to be followed for getting course certificate, attendance certificate and all their certificates.

TUTORIAL SYSTEM

Every student admitted in our college is under the care of a teacher who acts as his/her tutor. He / She guides the students (wards) assigned to him/her in all his/her educational welfare and other matters.

All the leave applications and other application for issue of certificates such as course certificate, attendance certificate, identity certificate and monthly progress reports etc..., of the ward are to be countersigned by the tutor/HOD. Application without tutor's counter signature will not be entertained at the college office.
