COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE which expression shall, wherever the context so permits mean and include successors and assigns.)

WHEREAS

Now this MoU witnesses as under:

1. SCOPE OF THE MOU

K.M.G. COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE hereby agrees to implement Entrepreneurship Cluster Development Program for the students aspiring to become entrepreneurs in their institution. An initiative to nurture aspiring students/entrepreneurs across the State of Tamil Nadu and guide them towards beginning/running a successful business enterprise on their own.

2. ROLE OF ICT ACADEMY

- 2.2. Will provide the template for Printing of Marketing Collaterals
- 2.3. Shall provide Handouts to the beneficiaries if any available
- 2.4. Shall provide Self learning access to the students.
- 2.5. Conduct Assessments as and when required.
- 2.6. Certification to all successful students on fulfilling the criteria.
- 2.7. Conduct Awareness Sessions, Mentoring Sessions, Training sessions as per the project plan

3. ROLE OF K.M.G. COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE

- 3.1. Shall work along with ICT Academy in mobilising the students from 2021 – 2022 passing out/Passed out Students to take up the Training.
- 3.2. Should take declaration from the student that they will not discontinue the program
- 3.3. Shall appoint one coordinator to coordinate between ICT Academy and the Institution
- 3.4. Organise an Inauguration function and cover the training with Photographs & Videos.
- 3.5. Shall provide necessary infrastructure if any required.
- 3.6. Submit all acknowledgements and reports as per the requisites of the Project.

4. OPERATION OF THIS MOU

Upon execution of this MoU, ICT Academy shall communicate to K.M.G. COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE and the training schedules. Thereupon, the Parties shall mutually discuss and agree on the operational terms based on which ICT Academy would offer its services.

5. VALIDITY OF THIS MOU

6. CONFIDENTIALITY

- 6.1. The Parties shall treat all information, documents, contents and materials pertaining to ICT Academy or K.M.G. COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE provided under this MoU as confidential.
- 6.2. ICT Academy or K.M.G. COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE shall not disclose any aspect of any confidential information to any third party in any manner whatsoever other than in the normal course of agreed terms under this MoU.
- 6.3. The confidentiality of information shall survive the termination of this Agreement.
- 6.4. Upon the termination of this MOU, K.M.G. COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE shall return all the contents, training materials and such other information provided by ICT Academy under this MoU duly without any undue delay and in cases where such information is not capable of being returned the same and provide a certificate to that to ICT Academy.

7. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 7.1. All the intellectual property rights with respect to the programs, contents provided by ICT Academy shall vest with ICT Academy and upon the termination of this Agreement by efflux of time or such other earlier termination, the college shall not have the right to use programs, contents, and such other training materials installed under this MoU and return the same to ICT Academy. K.M.G.



COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE, shall not infringe the intellectual property rights of ICT Academy and shall duly intimate of any such infringement by any third parties.

8. INDEMNITY

8.1. Both K.M.G. COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE and ICT Academy agree to hold harmless and indemnify each other, from and against all action, demands, proceedings, prosecutions, attachments, claims or causes of action whatsoever, including (but not limited to) attorneys' fees and other costs arising out of:

- (a) Any breach of this Agreement by either party
- (b) Any negligence on the part of either party

9. NOTICES

All notices regarding this Agreement shall be by personal delivery or by certified or registered mail, postage prepaid, at the addresses as either of them may so provide by notice given to the other in the same manner.

10. GOVERNING LAW

This MOU is made under and shall be governed by and construed under the laws of the Republic of India under the jurisdiction of the courts at Chennai.

11. ARBITRATION

In the event of any claim, controversy, dispute or difference between Parties, arising out of or in connection with or in relation to this Agreement, either Party will be entitled refer the same to arbitration in accordance with the rules of arbitration of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996.

There shall be three arbitrators, one to be appointed by ICT Academy, the other to be appointed by K.M.G. COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE and the third to be appointed by the two arbitrators appointed by the Parties. The award of the arbitrators shall be final and binding on the Parties. The Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Chennai.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This non-binding Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into Gudiyattam 13th Day of August 2019.

BETWEEN

M/s. K.M.G. COLLEGE OF ARTS & SCIENCE, DEPARTMENT OF BIOCHEMISTRY hereafter "KMGC", with a registered address at RAILWAY STATION ROAD, AMMANANKUPPAM, GUDIYATTAM, VELLORE DISTRICT, TAMIL NADU, INDIA

AND

M/s. BCX BIOORGANICS hereafter "", with a registered address at 11, Survey No. 38/1, Krishnasagara, Attibele, Anekal Taluk, Bangalore- 562 107.

KMGC and are referred to collectively, as "Parties" or individually as "Party."

1. Purpose

The Parties recognize the benefits to be derived from increased collaboration, cooperation and interaction for the further research and development activities on Biochemistry and Biotechnology (hereafter, collectively referred to as the "Field").

The purpose of this MOU is to define the areas for fundamental, academic research in which the Parties desire to work together in the future for their mutual benefit to foster a collaborative framework between KMGC and BCX BIO ORGANICS in the Field with a view of benefiting from each other's initiatives and working procedures and to support collaboration among the researchers associated with both Parties.

2. Scope

This MOU sets forth the intentions of the Parties for increased collaboration, cooperation and interaction and does not create any legally binding commitments. If the Parties later agree to undertake specific joint projects with legally binding obligations, they will develop separate written agreements for such projects, setting out each Party's contributions, deliverables, and budgets.

It is understood that KMGC is Permanently affiliated to Thiruvalluvar University under the regulations of University Grants Commission, Government of India so the activities undertaken by KMGC under this MOU, or any subsequent agreements, must be in accordance with the UGC guidelines and regulations. Similarly, it is also understood that BCX BIO ORGANICS is a National certified Organics production facility with tissue culture facility. The activities undertaken by BCX BIO ORGANICS under this MOU, or any subsequent agreements, must be in accordance with the guidelines and regulations.

The parties collaborate, cooperate and interact to achieve the following scopes of this MOU.

1. The Parties intend to pursue collaboration on fundamental, academic research, related to applications of plant biotechnology in agriculture and its allied fields.
 - Clonal propagation of banana and bamboo

- Plant molecular biology
 - Commercial plant tissue culture
 - Sapling of G9 plants
 - Vermicompost technology
 - Plant cloning
 - Strain Improvement techniques
 - Synthesis of nanoparticles by green technology
 - Conservation of endangered plant species by tissue culture techniques.
 - Entrepreneurship skill development in biotechnology
 - Phytoremediation techniques
 - Production of biofertilizers and its testing
 - Production of biopesticides.
 - Production of plant hormones (Growth regulators)
 - Information sharing on Intellectual Property Rights related to plant biotechnology
 - Hands on training on Instrumental methods
 - Implant training and industrial visits for students and staff
2. Both parties exchange the technical expertise in sharing experimental procedures, instrumental knowledge and development of new protocols.
 3. Both parties agree to exchange the expertise of their working staff under mutual convenience when requested by either Party. However, exchange of faculties or staff or scientist is to be done under mutual convenience of the Parties when such exchanges doesn't affect the normal functioning of the Parties. During Conferences, Seminars, Symposia and Workshops organized by either Party, above mentioned exchange of working staff may avail with mutual concerns.

4. Both Parties agree to utilize their facilities when and where required, such utilizations doesn't affect the normal functioning of the Parties.

3. Costs

3.1 Each Party will be responsible for its own costs in connection with all matters relating to collaborations under this MOU. Where possible and appropriate, the Parties may also seek funding for collaborations from other government and private agencies.

4. General Provisions

4.1 As stated above, any specific joint projects will be set forth in separate written agreements.

4.2 Treatment of intellectual property rights developed through collaborations under this MOU will be determined between the Parties through mutual consultation and separate written agreements on a case-by-case basis.

4.3. Publication credits of any kind arising as a result of this MOU shall be shared by both the Parties. The lead authors would be the Party where major part of the experiments conducted. The corresponding authors of the publications would be the Party which has prepared the manuscript. The above issues will be discussed by the parties and decide the authorship details. The publications as a result of this MOU will be made under mutual concerns of the Parties while either Party is intimated verbally.

5. Confidentiality

5.1. The parties agree that there is no intention to share any confidential or proprietary information in any collaboration under this MOU. If either Party wishes to disclose information it considers to be confidential or proprietary to the other Party, the Parties will enter into a written non-disclosure agreement.

6. Duration

6.1 This MOU shall be effective for a period of FIVE (5) years from the date of final signature. It may be modified or extended by mutual written agreement by the Parties. This MOU may be terminated by either party upon THREE (3) months advance written notice.

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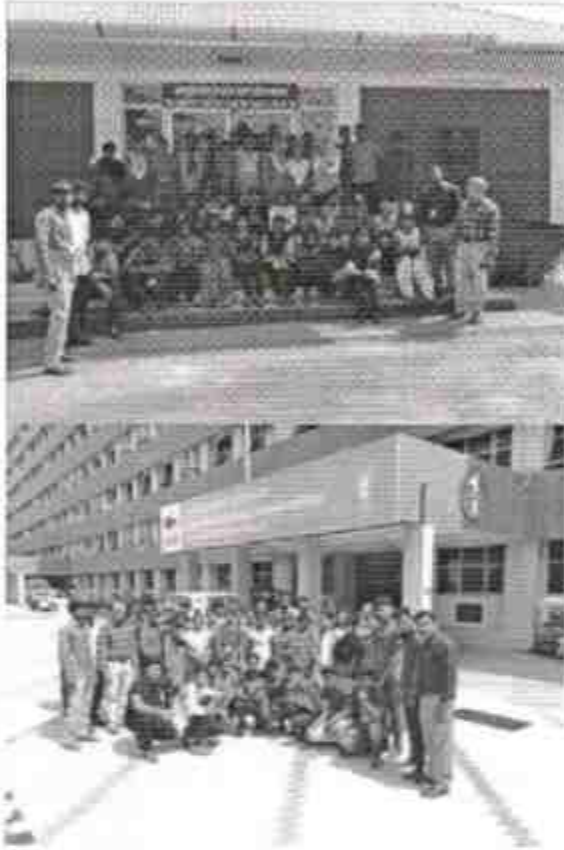
