

# Day 01: Registration, Inauguration and lecture on "An ideal Teacher" and "Stress and stress management"

The Registration for the "Tamilnadu State Council for Science and technology, Chennai" Catalyzed and supported "In-service Training programme for science teachers of Vellore District" started at 09.30 am of the total 50 teachers who were officially selected a total of 50 science teacher participants from various schools of Vellore district turned up and registered themselves for the above training programme. There were 29 female participants and 21 Male participants. The participants were provided with training kit which included a folder, notepad and pen .The inauguration of the "In-service Training programme for science teachers of Vellore District" was done of 05.01.2024 in the K.M.G.College of arts and Science, Gudiyattam at 10.00 am. ### Day 03: Special lecture and hands on training on "Magic Numerals" and "Microbiology"

M.Sc.,M.Phil.,Head and Assistant Professor in maths on Scientific maths and its importance, potential applications. In her lecture she stress upon the importance of practical maths in science students and the importance of the latest advancements in the field. After a short tea break, she continued the hands-on training in the formulas employed for the physics and chemistry problems to school teachers who are much interested to do practical demo by math's teachers. After a lunch break, we also arranged a special session in the Microbiology lab by Dr. N.Sundaramoorthy Ph.D., and Dr. A.M.Rajalakshmi Ph.D., where the teacher were introduced to the various instrumentation facilities available in the department followed by hands-on training on basic and advanced training in microbiology.
