ACTIVITIES OF THE COMMITTEE FOR THE YEAR 2022-2023

The following agendas were discussed in the meeting.

1. Attendance shortage students were instructed to attend the class regularly.
2. Students were asked to concentrate more on university examinations.
3. The Parents were made to learn about their children's academic progression
4. Moreover the parents were instructed to refrain from giving cell phones to their children to college.
5. Students should display a higher degree of discipline and good conduct.

8. Students must carry identity card during college hours.

11. Dress code is compulsory. Identity cards will be confiscated by the disciplinary committee and action will be taken if there is violation of code.
12. Outside foods are not allowed inside the campus.

14. Students should pay due to all the teachers' alike.
15. Serious action will be taken by the Discipline Board if a student remains indiscipline.
16. Students should not involve in unlawful activities in the campus, if found so, they will be dismissed immediately.
17. It is important to students to observe discipline during college hours.
18. Students are expected to get inside the classrooms by the first bell itself.
19. Students should not leave the classrooms without the permission of lectures when teaching is in progress.
20. Students Grievances will be addressed with due importance.
21. Tutors and Mentors will intensively monitor the student's attendance, progress and conduct.

Irregular attendance, indifference towards attending classes and exams, disobedience towards teachers, offensive activities, damaging college properties or involving any kind of antisocial activities will be viewed seriously. Such student will face elimination from the college on the grounds of disciplinary action.
