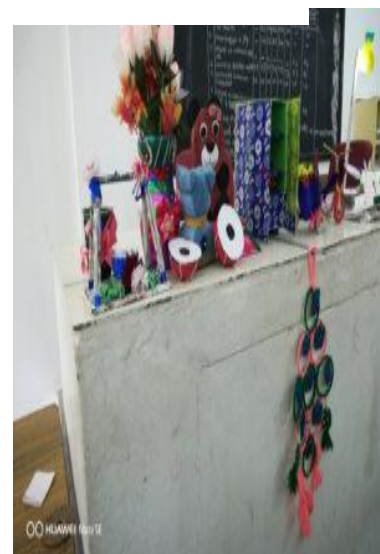
Event 3: Biochemistry Department Association Inauguration
