### The Agenda were:

- 1. Approval of the Minutes of the First Board of Studies meeting held on 17.05.2024.
- 2. Review, approval, and passing of the courses offered by the Department of Chemistry for the second semester of the B.Sc. and M.Sc. Chemistry programs.
- Review of feedback on the syllabus and course outcomes for the 2024-25 academic year (First Semester).
- 4. Review, approval, and passing of the elective courses offered by the Department of Chemistry for Botany and Zoology students in the second semester.
- 5. Review of the course outcomes for second-semester subjects, addressing different cognitive levels (K1 to K6) in the UG and PG curriculum.
- 6. Discussion of any other matters brought forward by BoS members.

#### Discussion:

- 1. The course outcomes (COs) for all courses under the UG and PG program were thoroughly reviewed. Members noted the importance of aligning COs with the program outcomes (POs) to ensure effective delivery and assessment of the curriculum.
- 2. Mapping of each CO to POs was evaluated for accuracy, emphasizing the cognitive levels (K1–K6) outlined in Bloom's Taxonomy.
- The repetition of topics like "Addition to Carbon-Hetero Atom Multiple Bonds" was discussed, and it was suggested that such overlaps dilute the effectiveness of mapped outcomes.

### Suggestions:

- 1. Ensure that each CO distinctly contributes to one or more specific POs without redundancy.
- 2. Ensure each CO addresses a range of levels, from basic knowledge (K1) to higher-order skills like evaluation (K5) and creation (K6).
- Removing redundancies like repeated discussions on "Addition to Carbon-Hetero Atom Multiple Bonds" improves the alignment between COs and the curriculum's intended outcomes.


#### Resolution:


- The minutes of the First Board of Studies meeting held on 17.05.2024 were presented, reviewed, and unanimously approved by the committee.

- 4. The repetitive sections under "Addition to Carbon-Hetero Atom Multiple Bonds" were consolidated, ensuring a focused and streamlined syllabus.
- 5. The revised syllabus was approved unanimously by the Board of Studies, and it will be implemented for the upcoming academic year.


