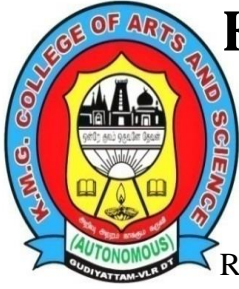

Hemraj S Joshi. His insights and perspectives on managing personal finances and the importance of financial planning would have provided valuable knowledge to the students.

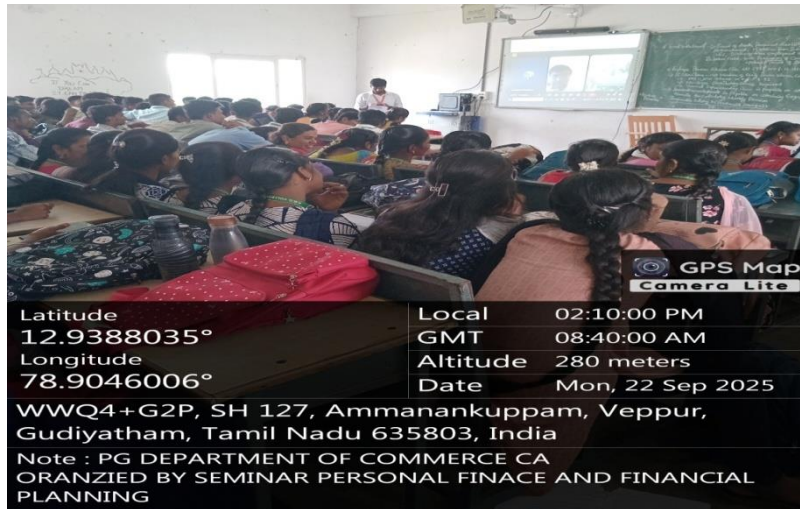

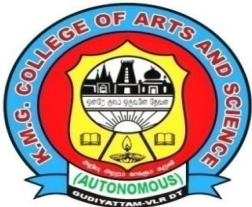
Plenary Session: Emerging Trends: Generative AI in Business and Finance

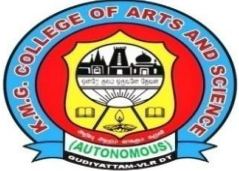

Keynote Session

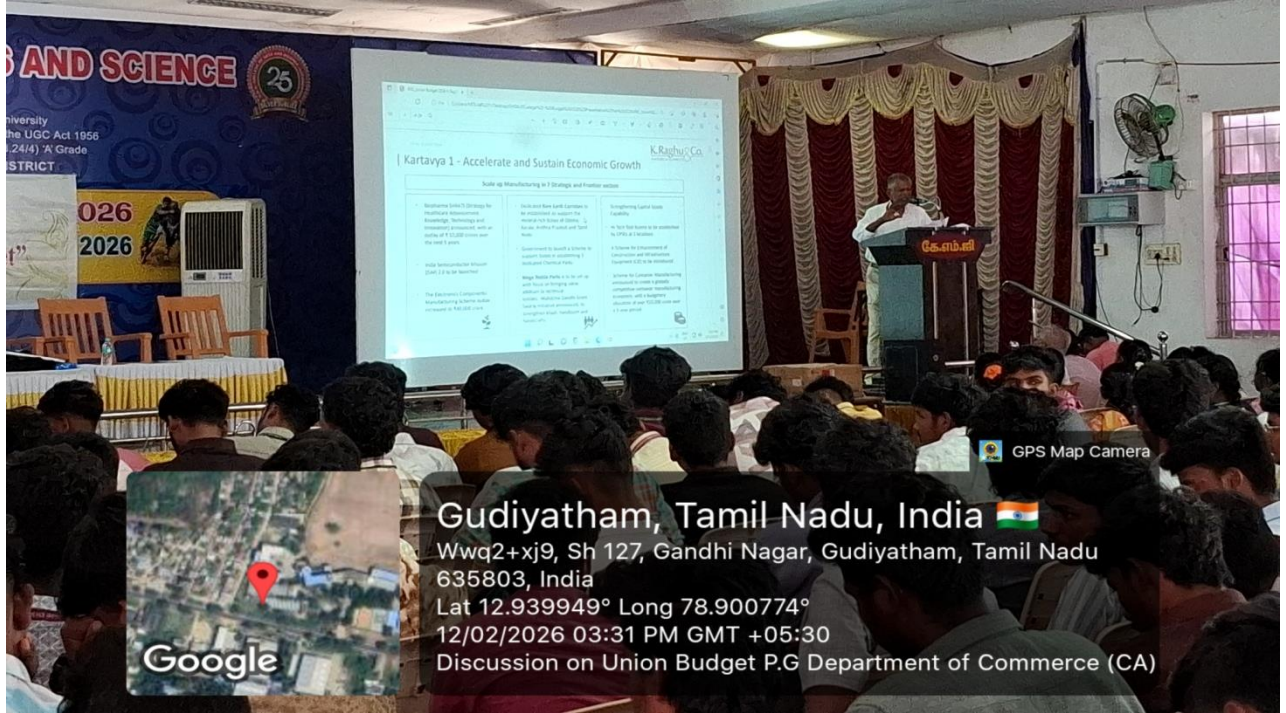

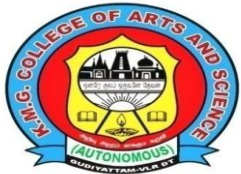
